We focused on the letter Ee and Ll.

This week we read Where the Wild Things Are

- We worked on sequencing the story as a whole class and then in our small reading groups we worked on the beginning, middle, and end of the story.
- We made a class book "If I were a wild thing, I would..."
- We talked about Wild and Tame and drew pictures to show what they would look like.
- We created a sort and had to place pictures under the correct heading: pretend or real.
- We also worked on vocabulary from the book and talked about what some of the words mean.
- We drew pictures and wrote about what would happen if we were leaders for the day.
- We talked about what was real and what was pretend in the story.
- This week for laptops we created our own monsters on the paint program. We got to print them out and take them home. We thought that was really cool!
- We continue to practice on our handwriting and this week we focused on the letters Ee and LI.
- We are also working on our sounds. We will be starting to work with a sound chart to help us stretch our words out in order to spell words and write them.


